#### A Time of Transition



Once I've composed this letter, my primary tasks this week, will be to prepare a sermon for the Feast of Christ the King, the last Sunday of the Church's year, and to draw together my final service rota – the job I took on for the period of the vacancy. The end of the liturgical year and the final phase of the vacancy... a coincidence that pleases my love of symmetry!

I think it's right that, as we look ahead to the arrival of our new rector, we should acknowledge the hard work of the

churchwardens and PCC members who drew together the parish profile, the congregation members who welcomed the candidates on orientation day and the parish representatives who formed the interview panel, along with Bishop Jackie, Archdeacon Andrew and two representatives of the patrons of St Gregory's. The whole process was challenging and

particularly the interviews, when faced with choosing between candidates with different gifts and aptitudes, knowing that the future of those people and that of the benefice is in your hands. So heartfelt thanks go to all of you and also to Leena, who did sterling work in coordinating communications through the months and, even though not on the interview panel, kept them supplied with refreshments throughout a demanding day.





As I hope everyone knows by now, the post of Rector was offered to the Reverend Linda Cronin, who was pleased to accept. She and her husband, Steve, will be moving to Dawlish from their current ministry on the outskirts of Belfast at the beginning of February. They will be living in the former curate's house in Shillingate Close, where renovations are being carried out in preparation. The long-time vicarage in Westcliff Road will continue to be let by the diocese, while a decision is made as to its

future. The newer house will be much more comfortable and easier to heat and to maintain.

Linda's licensing will take place at St Gregory's on the evening of Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> February, the day after Ash Wednesday, when we will all have the opportunity to gather to welcome Linda and Steve, to pray for their ministry here and to rededicate ourselves to work together to the glory of Christ's Kingdom here in Dawlish, Cofton, Holcombe and Starcross.

As anyone knows, who has worked out a period of notice in an old job, while planning the next and getting to grips as well with moving house, it's a strange time of transition. Much as Linda is looking forward to moving home — she grew up in Newton Abbot and was ordained and served in the Church of England before her move to Ireland — she still has another congregation to lead. So, she and Steve need our prayers now. Please keep them in mind.





And it's a time of transition for us too. Now that we have a date for Linda's arrival, we will focus entirely on the job in hand. Any decisions about the future will be left for her to make. So please be patient. Live for today. There's plenty to keep us occupied as December approaches. We've worked together so well to not only maintain but also grow the Church

these past months. I pray that we will continue joyfully and look forward hopefully as this year gives way to the next.

God, who called you to his eternal glory in Christ, make you strong to do his will; and the peace and blessing of the Lord be always with you.




### St Greg's Christmas Tree Festival
