A Happy New Year from all at St Georges

The changes over the past few years have been very significant for St Georges. The loss of our vicar Chris, the appointment of a new vicar, Dallas, shared between four churches, the changes to worship during several years of Covid, the loss of Dallas and the appointment of Linda as a new shared vicar. We are very fortunate to have a number of retired clergy and lay readers around Holcombe, Paul, Fiona, Sue and Ceri who have looked after the services for us in an outstanding way. We are also very grateful to Ian playing regularly for us.

Holcombe, as a village, has few children and a large older population. As a result, the electoral roll has shrunk because of people dying or moving into nursing homes or to be closer to their family later in life. In spite of this the church is still flourishing with an average attendance at our weekly service of over thirty people. The majority of people stay for coffee after the service.

At the recent Carol Service and Crib Service this Christmas, over seventy people attended each service and we had lovely feedback from people.

We were fortunate to have a harpist, Sonia Mistely at our Carol Service (see photo further down the page). She played before and after, which created a very special service.

We look forward to the New Year with the arrival of Linda. In the meantime, church life continues. In addition to the services, we run a Drop In, for people to meet and chat. A Warmer Place which serves homemade soups for lunch and Eat and Enlightenment, an evening meal and discussion group at the Castle Pub.

The increase in electricity price over the last couple of years has meant we now do



not heat the church but only the people. We no longer use the night storage heaters and only switch the electric heaters on for a few hours before and during the services and any other use. This has enabled us to reduce heating costs even with the higher electricity prices.

The church is open every day thanks to Brian and Vanessa who unlock and lock the church. In the summertime we get many visitors to both the church and garden in spite of being off the beaten track.


We wish Linda and her family all the best as they move into our churches.
